ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES AGM 2018 The minutes of the AGM 2018 had been distributed to all members and were unanimously accepted. Proposed by: Gawie Viljoen Seconded by: Bernard Fourie</p> <p>5. MATTERS FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES All matters were included in the Chairman's Report.</p> <p>6. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT 2019 The Chairman's Report is available on the website and at the local shop (Oyster Bay Residents' Association Notice Board).</p> <p>Only crucial points were therefore discussed. Questions were welcome.</p> <p>6.1 ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS Walter thanked Joe for his hard work. During July Joe was present on the dunes from early morning until late afternoon in the wet, windy winter weather. Chris Jansen supervised the work in Joe's absence for a few days and he also extended his appreciation, via email.</p> <p>Joe Meyer gave feedback:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The target for completion of the dune project was almost reached and maintenance work must be done - KM budgeted for this - 4 times a year. Brander Street has already been opened twice, 2 properties have been opened and 10 open
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10 oop erwe is nou weer bruikbaar.

- Rehabilitasie van duine moet so spoedig moontlik begin. Geen drinkwater sal vir dié doel aangewend word nie en ongeveer R200 000 is deur KM begroot hiervoor. 'n Deklaag sal gegooi word om die groei van plante te bevorder.
- Die sandvangslote het goed gewerk en die sterk wind sedert Julie het die taak baie moeilik gemaak en indien hierdie instandhouding gestop word sal nog meer eiendomme bedreig word.
- Goeie ondersteuning is ontvang van KM se burgemeester en die span van omgewingsake.

Christa van Wyk doen navraag oor die koste van die projek tot op datum en voel dat dit geldmors is en voel dat die probleem nooit opgelos sal word nie en dat dit soos 'n oop myngroef lyk.

Kobus de Meyer doen navraag oor die wetlike beperking end beweer dat die sand nie meer as 100 meter van die hoogwatermerk gestoot mag word nie.

Tommy Bornman, Professor aan Nelson Mandelabaai Universiteit opper die volgende besware:

- Sand is oor die goedgekeurde perk en in die see ingestoot en dit benadeel die ekosisteem.
- Die wal wat gestoot is lyk nie mooi nie.
- Bulldozer werk die afgelope 2 dae op die duin – dit is onwettig aangesien daar nie 'n veiligheidsoffisier teenwoordig is nie.
- Die gooi van 'n grondlaag op die duine om die plantegroei te bevorder. Hy stel voor dat dit op 'n klein area uitgetoets word en die resultaat met DEDEAT bespreek word.
- Seevlak gaan styg as gevolg van klimaatsverandering en sand in see inspoel.

Joe bedank almal vir hul insette en noem dat baie geleer is sedert die aanvang van die projek en nooi belangstellendes uit om om 'n tafel te sit en hul insette te bespreek.

- Die goedgekeurde plan word vertoon en Joe

stands are now usable again.

- Rehabilitation should start as soon as possible. No drinking water will be used for this purpose and approximately R200000 has been budgeted by KM for this. A mulch layer will be thrown to promote plant growth.
- The sand traps have worked well and the strong wind since July made the task very difficult and if this maintenance is stopped even more properties will be threatened.
- Good support was received from KM's mayor and environmental affairs team.

Christa van Wyk inquired about the cost of the project to date and felt that it is a waste of money and that the problem will never be solved and that it looks like an open mining quarry.

Kobus de Meyer inquired about the legal restriction and alleged that the sand may not be pushed more than 100 meters from the high water mark.

Tommy Bornman, Professor at Nelson Mandela Bay University raised the following objections:

- Sand has been pushed over the approved boundary and into the sea, damaging the ecosystem.
- The embankment being pushed does not look pretty.
- Bulldozer has been working on the dune for the past 2 days - it is illegal as there is no security officer present.
- Throwing a mulch layer on the dunes to promote vegetation. He suggested to test it on a small area and then discuss the results with DEDEAT.
- Sea level will rise as a result of climate change and the sand being washed into the sea.

Joe thanked everyone for their input and mentioned that much had been learned since the start of the project and invited interested parties to get together and discuss their input.

- The approved plan was displayed and Joe

- Joe bevestig dat die oophou van die Slangriviermond ook hanteer word. Die droogte het 'n groot impak aangesien die rivier vir baie lank nie meer self deurloop see toe om die vloepad oop te hou nie.

Daar word gepoog om 'n klomp balle in die lug te hou en die OIV probeer hul bes om als te hanteer.

Willie du Plessis versoek dat Oesterbaaiers mekaar in ag moet neem en nie net in eie belang moet optree nie. Ons moet saamstaan, saamwerk en insette gee. Die omgewingsprobleem raak almal!

Fanie Groenewald noem dat indien niks aan die duine gedoen is nie, die doodsklok lankal vir Oesterbaai sou lui en dat Oesterbaai eventueel nie meer toeganklik sou wees nie. Dit gaan nog lank neem, maar danksy Joe, DEDEAT en KM is daar 'n plan.

Louisa Mostert doen navraag oor die toegangspad na Klippepunt wat oor die hoofstrand loop. Voertuie wat tussen vakansiegangers deur is gevaarlik en sy wil weet of daar nie 'n alternatiewe pad is nie. Joe bevestig dat dit ongelukkig tans die mees geskikte plek vir die pad is aangesien toestemming om die deurpad tussen Oesterlaan en Branderstraat te herbou nie deur DEDEAT goedgekeur is nie.

explained that all work had been done according to the approved engineering plans and that permission had been given to push the sand up to the high water mark. The tidal pool that pushed in is but a phenomenon that happens at any beach. It is just suddenly there and then it moves to another area.

- ± R3.5m already spent - about R1.2 from KM and the rest donations by the owners.
- Rehabilitation work already done was very successful and the dunes on the west side of Brander Street (in front of his house) are already overgrown and stable.
- The sand traps are also very successful and he indicated this on a map.
- It must be decided what the solution is and what we want to achieve. Inputs will be welcomed.
- Joe also confirmed that the mouth of the Snake River was also handled. The drought had a big impact as the river no longer runs through to the sea to keep the flow path open.

Attempts are made to keep a lot of balls in the air and the OBBRA is trying their best to handle everything.

Willie du Plessis requested that Oyster Bayer's should consider each other and not just act in their own interests. We must stand together, work together and give input. The environmental problem affects everyone!

Fanie Groenewald mentioned that if nothing had been done to the dunes, the death bell would have been ringing for Oyster Bay for a long time and that Oyster Bay might not be accessible at all. It's going to take a long time, but thanks to Joe, DEDEAT and KM there is a plan.

Louisa Mostert inquired about the access road to Klippepunt which runs over the main beach. Vehicles traveling between holidaymakers are dangerous and she wanted to know if there is no alternative road.

Joe confirmed that unfortunately, this is currently the most suitable place for the road as permission to rebuild the road between Oester Avenue and Brander Street has not been approved by DEDEAT.

Johan noem ook dat almal geleentheid gehad het om beswaar aan te teken toe die proses begin is.

6.2 WATERVOORSIENING

Otto Pepler gee terugvoering:

- Die waterbalans is huidig baie goed en daar is ongeveer 50k/m per dag spaar. Indien water spaarsamig gebruik word behoort daar genoeg water te wees gedurende die vakansieseisoen.

Die boorgate lewer goeie water, een van die fonteine het opgedroog maar die ander een loop goed.

- Die twee nuwe boorgate is nog nie toegerus nie, hoofsaaklik as gevolg van 'n tekort aan fondse.

Die nuwe pyplyn na die reservoir is ook nog nie voltooi nie aangesien die begroting daarvoor nie voldoende was nie.

- Tydens 'n vergadering met Willie Botha is bevestig dat beide bogenoemde projekte vroeg volgende jaar aangespreek sal word en dat dit deur KM befonds sal word.
- KM het twee permanente persone aangestel om om te sien na Oesterbaai se waterbehoefte en danksy hulle en die voorman se harde werk en toewyding verloop alles vlot en klagtes word vining aangespreek en opgelos.

6.3 GEMEENSKAPSAAL

Walter Kurten rapporteer dat die ooreenkoms met KM vir die bestuur van die saal nog van krag is.

Die Bestuurskomitee het verskeie instandhoudingsprojekte by die saal hanteer. Belangstelling vir die huur van die saal was ongelukkig beperk en die behoefte aan verkoeling en kookgeriewe is telkens geopper. Martiens het intussen 2 tweedehandse yskaste

He pledged to maintain the road and mentioned that a possible solution will be to get people with red flags to accompany the vehicles during the holiday season. The problem will be addressed

Johan Jacobs thanked Joe again for his hard work, sometimes under difficult circumstances that are accompanied by great sacrifice. He also confirmed that Joe's services are offered for free and the community is thus saved a lot of money. Johan also mentioned that everyone had the opportunity to object when the process started.

6.2 WATER SUPPLY

Otto Pepler gave feedback.

- The water balance is currently very good and there is about 50k/m per day spare capacity. If water is used sparingly, there should be enough water during the holiday season.

The boreholes provide good water, one of the fountains has dried up but the other is running well.

- The two new boreholes are not yet equipped, mainly due to a shortage of funds. The new pipeline to the reservoir has also not been completed as the budget was insufficient.

- During a meeting with Willie Botha, it was confirmed that both of the above projects will be addressed early next year and that it will be funded by KM.
- KM has appointed two permanent people to look after Oyster Bay's water needs and they and their foreman were thanked for the hard work and dedication to make sure that everything goes smoothly and complaints are addressed and resolved.

6.3 COMMUNITY HALL

Walter Kurten reported that the agreement with KM for the management of the hall is still in force.

The Management Committee handled various maintenance projects at the hall.

Unfortunately, interest in renting the hall was limited and the need for cooling and cooking facilities was raised every time. Martiens has meanwhile acquired 2 second-hand refrigerators

6.4 AFVALSTORTINGSTERREIN

Deurlopende insette is nodig om die terrein in 'n aanvaarbare toestand te hou.
Die randte van die aflaaibrug is gebou alhoewel die werk weereens substandaard was. 'n Waghuis en toilet is ook aangebring.
Sommige inwoners stort steeds hul afval voor die hek wanneer die terrein na-ure gesluit is. Ons moedig toesighouers aan om hierdie persone by die Munisipale Polisie te rapporteer. Reëlings is getref dat die ure by die terrein tydens die vakansie verleng word.
Die glasherwinningshouer is ongelukkig deur die maatskappy verantwoordelik daarvoor verwyder aangesien dit nie vir hulle lonend is nie. Die Munisipaliteit het onderneem om glas wat in aparte houers geplaas word vir herwinning weg te neem.
'n Vriendelike versoek word weer aan almal gerig om hul vullissakke nie op die sypaadjie te los wanneer hulle vertrek nie aangesien die ape, rondloperhonde en muishonde dit oopskeur. Neem asseblief die vullis na die stortingsterrein en indien dit gesluit is, plaas dit in die blou vullisdromme wat deur die Bestuurskomitee op verskeie plekke aangebring is. Die moontlikheid om 'n paar van hierdie dromme voor die stortingsterrein te plaas sal ondersoek word.

6.5 PAAIE

Joe het gedurende die jaar weer herstelwerk aan die paaie gedoen en hy onderneem om voortdurend aandag hieraan te gee.
Ons het gedurende die jaar verskeie gesprekke met Provinsiale amptenare oor die paaie vanaf Humansdorp en St Francis gehad. Hulle het intussen toestemming gekry om gruis te bekom van een van die omliggende plase en 'n EIA sal gedoen word. Dit sal die gruis van hierdie paaie veel goedkoper maak aangesien die vervoer van die gruis goedkoper sal wees.
Tydens 'n besoek van die Burgemeester het ons die swak paaie in Umzamowethu as 'n behoefte gestel en verskeie paaie in Umzamowethu en Oesterbaai is kort daarna hergruis.

and the need for a stove will be addressed in the new year.

The hall's roof is disintegrating. KM is responsible for greater maintenance work and constant pressure is being put on them.

6.4 REFUSE DUMPING SITE

Continuous input is required to keep the site in acceptable condition.
The edges of the download bridge were built although the work was once again substandard. A guardhouse and toilet were also provided. Some residents still dump their waste in front of the gate when the site is closed after hours. We encourage supervisors to report these persons to the Municipal Police.
Arrangements have been made to extend the hours at the site during the holidays.
Unfortunately, the glass recycling container was removed by the company responsible for this as it is not profitable for them. The Municipality undertook to remove glass placed in separate containers for recycling.

A friendly request was once again made for everyone not to leave their garbage bags on the sidewalk when they leave as the monkeys, stray dogs and mongoose tear it open. Please take the garbage to the refuse dumping site and, if it is closed, place it in the blue garbage bins provided by the Management Committee at various locations. The possibility of placing some of these bins in front of the refuse dumping site will be explored.

6.5 ROADS

Joe did some road repairs during the year and undertook to pay constant attention to the roads.
During the year we had several conversations with Provincial officials about the roads from Humansdorp and St Francis. In the meantime, they have been granted permission to obtain gravel from one of the surrounding farms and an EIA will be conducted. This will make the gravel of these roads much cheaper as the transport of the gravel will be cheaper.
During a visit from the Mayor, we put down the poor roads in Umzamowethu as a need and several roads in Umzamowethu and Oyster Bay were graveled soon afterwards.

6.6 KOMMUNIKASIE EN NUUSBRIEWE

Die Bestuurskomitee het by sy eerste vergadering hierdie jaar besluit om nie voort te gaan met die drie-maandelikse nuusbriewe nie, maar om eerder gereeld terugvoering oor gebeure en sake van belang per kort, saaklike boodskappe op WhatsApp-groepe te kommunikeer. Persone wat nie hierdie boodskappe wil ontvang nie, is welkom om die groepe te verlaat.

Ons jaarlikse Desember OesterbaaiNUUS is weer deur Fanie saamgestel en hy word bedank vir die spogweergawe. Oysterbay Lodge word bedank vir die borg en verspreiding daarvan.

6.7 BRANDWEER

Die Burgemeester het bevestig dat die bou van die brandweerdepot wel sal voortgaan, maar kon nie bevestig wanneer nie. Dit is ook tydens die IDP-sessies bevestig en daar is onderneem om terugvoering te gee.

6.8 UMZAMOWETHU

Adriaan van Wyk spreek bekommernis uit oor die sosio-ekonomiese toestande in Umzamowethu asook die reuse probeem van drank- en dwelmisbruik onder die kinders. Die span van Living Water en die skoolhoof van Sandwater Primêr, Hennie Ferreira, lewer 'n reuse bydra tot die welstand van Umzamowethu se kinders.

Die Living Ubuntu Crèche open vroeg in die nuwe jaar en behoort 'n groot inset te lewer in die opvoeding van die kindertjies.

Adriaan het ook begin met 'n handvaardigheidsgroep en hul handwerk sal te koop aangebied word by die Kontreimark.

Fanie bedank vir Adriaan vir sy betrokkenheid en reuse werk wat hy doen in Umzamowethu - dit is 'n welsynstaak en hy versoek mense om betrokke te raak en hul hulp aan te bied.

6.9 VUURWERKE

Die afvuur van vuurwerke is onwettig en veroorsaak 'n brandgevaar. Almal se samewerking word gevra om geen vuurwerkte of papierlaterns af te vuur nie.

6.10 HONDE OP DIE STRAND

Willie du Plessis spreek sy kommer uit oor die groot toename in honde sonder leibande op die strand en sommige mense

6.6 COMMUNICATION/NEWSLETTERS

During the first meeting of the Executive Committee it was decided that the three-monthly newsletters will be terminated and that regular feedback regarding matters of importance would rather be communicated via WhatsApp groups. People that do not want to receive these messages are welcome to just leave the groups.

The annual December OesterbaaiNUUS was again compiled by Fanie and he was thanked for this – something to be very proud of. Oyster Bay Lodge sponsored and distributed the newsletter and Walter extended our sincere thanks.

6.7 FIRE STATION

The Mayor confirmed that the project will continue but could not confirm the date. This was also confirmed during the recent IDP meetings and feedback was promised.

6.8 UMZAMOWETHU

Adriaan van Wyk stressed his concern about the socio-economic conditions in Umzamowethu as well as the huge problem of alcohol and drug abuse among the children.

The team of Living Water and the principal of Sandwater Primary, Hennie Ferreira, make a huge contribution to the well-being of Umzamowethu's children.

The Living Ubuntu Crèche opens early in the new year and should make a great contribution to the education of the children.

Adriaan also started a craft group and their products will be for sale at the Kontreimark. Fanie thanked Adriaan for his involvement and huge work that he does in Umzamowethu - it is a charity task and he asked people to get involved and offer their help.

6.9 FIRE WORKS

The use of fireworks is illegal and a fire hazard. Walter asked everyone's co-operation to refrain from the use of fireworks and paper lanterns.

6.10 DOGS ON THE BEACH

Willie du Plessis raised his concern about the increase of dogs without leashes on the beach and some people with no
