<p>VOORWOORD:</p> <p>Die verslag is 'n beknopte weergawe van die werksaamhede van die Bestuurskomitee. Die aktiwiteite van die Bestuurskomitee is veelvuldig. Alle aktiwiteite kan nie volledig in dié verslag vervat word nie.</p> <p>Oesterbaai het ook nie die gevolge van Covid 19 vrygespring nie. Dit is met hartseer dat ons die afsterwe van 'n paar oud-inwoners met lang verbintnisse met Oesterbaai moes aankondig.</p> <p>Ons bly tog van mening dat ons pogings tot dienslewering aan die Oesterbaai/Umzamowethu gemeenskap resultate lewer.</p>	<p>INTRODUCTION:</p> <p>This report is a concise account of the activities of the Management Committee. The activities of the Management Committee are numerous. A comprehensive report of all input is therefore not possible.</p> <p>The Covid 19 pandemic also resulted in hardship in Oyster Bay. It was with sorrow that we had to announce the passing on of some of our former residents, who had a long association with Oyster Bay.</p> <p>We remain of the opinion that our efforts to be of service to the Oyster Bay/Umzamowethu community bear effective results.</p>
<p>1. COVID 19 PANDEMIE Verantwoordelike komiteelid: Walter Kurten</p> <p>Ons het gedurende die verslag tydperk gereeld inligting oor die voorkoms van Covid 19-infeksies aan besorgde lede voorsien. COVID 19 PANDEMIC Responsible Committee Member: Walter Kurten</p> <p>We often provided information about the number of Covid infections to concerned members on request. This information was not shared on our WhatsApp groups, because the number of infections has never been a matter of concern. We are not aware of any deaths due to Covid 19, which was a result of an infection contracted in Oyster Bay or Umzamowethu. The Kouga Municipality's Face Book page frequently publishes Covid 19</p>

<p>Covid 19-statistieke van die Sara Baartman Distriksmunisipaliteit. Die groot woongebiede, o.a. Humansdorp, St. Francis, Jeffreysbaai en Hankey is gereeld as “Hotspot” areas aangedui. (“Hotspot verwys na die aantal infeksies per bevolking). Ek het ook versoeke ontvang vir die bekendmaking van die identiteit van Covid geïnfekteerdes. Ek glo u sal begrip hê dat dit wetlik uiters onverantwoordelik en strafbaar is om, sulke inligting bekend te maak.</p> <p>Ons het versoek gerig vir ‘n Covid inentingsklyniek in Oesterbaai. Amptenare van die Departement van Gesondheid het wel by twee geleenthede die Gemeenskapsaal besoek om die geskiktheid vir ‘n inentingsklyniek te bepaal en aangedui dat dit aan al die vereistes daarvoor voldoen. Ongelukkig moet inwoners steeds Humansdorp toe gaan vir inentings. Dit maak dit vir die inwoners van Umzawowethu baie moeilik, vanweë die kostes en ‘n dag van die werk af. Die inentingskoers is dus uiters laag.</p>	<p>statistics for the Sara Baartman District Municipality. The larger Towns, including Humansdorp, St Francis, Jeffreys Bay and Hankey were often identified as Hotspot areas (referring to the number of infections in relation to the population in the area). We also received requests for the identity of people infected. To comply with such requests will be punishable in terms of the law.</p> <p>We made representations to the authorities to have an immunisation clinic in Oyster Bay. Officials of the Department of Health visited the Community Hall at two occasions to evaluate if the hall will be adequate as an immunisation site. Both times the indicated that the Hall does comply with their requirements. Residents unfortunately have to travel to Humansdorp for their immunisation. Residents of Umzawowethu cannot afford the travel expenses and to stay away from work for a day. The number of people immunised is as a result extremely low.</p>

ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS Responsible Committee Member: Joe Meyer</p> <p>Dunes: Kouga Municipality removed a large amount of sand from the Eastern side of the dune during July and August.</p> <p>Joe again arranged with the Municipality to supply equipment to perform further work on the dune and to prepare for the holiday people. Joe will provide verbal feedback.</p> <p>The work Joe performed at the Slang River mouth last year resulted in the mouth remaining open against the western dune.</p>
<p>3. WATERVOORSIENING. Verantwoordelike Komiteelid: Otto Pepler en Buks Degenaar.</p> <p>Die watervoorsiening in Oesterbaai het die afgelope jaar minder probleme opgelewer as in vorige jare. WATER SUPPLY Responsible Committee Member: Otto Pepler and Buks Degenaar.</p> <p>We experienced much less problems with water supply in Oyster Bay the past year. Buks has seen to it that the few burst pipes received immediate</p>

<p>gebarste pype onmiddellik aandag geniet. Die samewerking van die munisipale amptenare in die verband is baie goed.</p> <p>Die amptenare doen daagliks rondtes om die situasie te monitor. Hulle verseker ons dat die pompe by die twee addisionele boorgate in werkende toestand is en afwisselend water na die reservoir pomp. Die sisteem is elektronies geoutomatiseer. Ongelukkig mag kragonderbrekings steeds probleme oplewer, omdat die meerderheid van die pompe nie bystand elektrisiteit het nie.</p> <p>Kouga en omgewing is steeds in 'n ernstige droogte vasgevang. Waterbeperkings geld steeds en die gebruik van tuinslange wat aan munisipale water gekoppel is, is steeds onwettig. 'n Beroep word op die inwoners en besoekers gedoen om die waterbeperkings te gehoorsaam.</p>	<p>attention. Co-operation of Municipal officials in this regard are good.</p> <p>The officials perform daily rounds to monitor the situation. They confirm that the pumps at the two additional bore holes are functional and that it pumps water alternately to the reservoir. The system is automated electronically. Power outages may unfortunately still result in disruptions of water supply, because the majority of pumps do not have electricity backup.</p> <p>Kouga and surrounding areas still experience serious drought. Water restrictions are still in place. Usage of hoses connected to municipal water is prohibited. We therefore again appeal to all residents and visitors to obey the water restrictions.</p>

GEMEENSKAPSAAL Verantwoordelike Komiteelid: Adriaan van Wyk</p> <p>Ons het in die vorige jaarverslag gemeld dat aansoek gedoen is vir 'n nuwe ooreenkoms vir die bestuur van die saal deur die OIV. Ongelukkig moet gemeld word dat ten spyte van deurlopende navrae, ook aan Horatio Hendriks (Burgemeester), die ooreenkoms nog nie afgehandel is nie. COMMUNITY HALL Responsible Committee Member: Adriaan van Wyk</p> <p>We mentioned in our 2020 report that an application was submitted for a new agreement for the management of the hall by OBRA. Unfortunately we have to report that this agreement is not yet finalised, although we followed up continuously with the Mayor amongst others. Further discussions are scheduled, also with the new Speaker, Brenton Williams. We will report on the outcome at the AGM.</p> <p>During early October a delegation of the Municipality visited the hall to perform a survey of the needs for maintenance and improvement of the Hall. They had a copy of our letter for the renewal of the tenancy of the hall. Undertakings for the replacement of the gutters (now completed), placement of rainwater tanks, replacement of window frames on the south facing side, a new covering for the floor, ceiling for the kitchen, warm water system, painting of the roof, etc. A broken wash basin has been replaced.</p> <p>The hall was often utilised this year, amongst others by a Pilatus training groups twice weekly;</p>

<p>5. AFVALSTORTINGSTERREIN Verantwoordelike Komiteelid: Adriaan van Wyk en Walter Kurten</p> <p>Die bestuur en instandhouding van die afvalstortingsterrein bly problematies. Reaksie het gevolg nadat ons weer 'n amptelike klagte by die verantwoordelike munisipale amptenaar hieroor ingedien het. Die waghuis is herbou en die netheid het verbeter.</p> <p>Ongelukkig ervaar ons dat sekere inwoners boumateriaal afval na-ure daar stort. Ons moedig die toesighouer aan om hierdie persone by die Munisipale Polisie aan te kla. Tans word die terrein weer na-ure gesluit.</p> <p>Ons versoek weereens dat u tydens vertrek u vullissakke nie op die sypaadjie sal laat nie. Dit word oopgeskeur deur honde, ape ens. REFUSE DUMPING SITE Responsible Committee Member: Adriaan van Wyk and Walter Kurten</p> <p>Management and maintenance of the dumping site remains problematic. After submission of a complaint to the responsible Municipal Manager, the site was tidied up The watch house was rebuilt and the neatness improved.</p> <p>Unfortunately some residents drop building rubbish there after hours. We encourage the Supervisor to report these residents to the Municipal Police. The site is now again locked after hours.</p> <p>We again appeal to you not to leave trash bags on pavements when leaving. Dogs, monkeys etc. scatter the contents. Please take your bags to the Rubbish Site. If it is closed, please dump it in any of the blue trash drums which the Management Committee has erected at various spots in Town.</p>

ROADS Responsible Committee Member: Joe Meyer, Buks Degenaar and Walter Kurten.</p> <p>Buks took the responsibility to repair the roads after severe flood damage this year. He had to keep on calling the Municipality to get the gravel delivered. Workers from the Municipality refused to flatten the gravel with shovels. Buks utilised local workers to do the work.</p> <p>Walter liaised on various occasions with the Provincial official responsible to repair the roads to</p>

<p>Humansdorp en St. Francis herstel te kry. Die tydelike “bruggie” net voor die St. Francis afdraai was uiters gevaarlik. Alhoewel dit steeds ‘n tydelike struktuur is, is dit behoorlik herstel. Nuwe gruislae is ook op plekke waar die paaie sleg verspoel het gegooi en gekompakteer. Na verskeie versoeke is die slaggate op die teerpad in Oesterbaai ook gevul.</p> <p>Joe het vandat hy in die derde week van November in Oesterbaai arriveer het, verdere herstelwerk aan die interne paaie gedoen. Keerwalle en dreineringslote wat hy vroeër aangebring het, het grootliks voorkom dat die paaie deur die swaar reën beskadig is.</p> <p>Ons het ook by meer as een geleentheid vertoë gerig vir die skraap van die paaie in Umzamowethu. Die reaksie was hierdie jaar baie beter as vorige jare.</p>	<p>Humansdorp and St Francis. The temporary bridge before the St Francis turn off was in a dangerous state. Although still a temporary structure, it was prepared properly. The roads were covered and compacted at the dangerous spots with additional gravel. After repeated requests. The potholes in Oyster Bay were also filled.</p> <p>Joe performed further repairs to the roads in Oyster Bay after his arrival the third week of November. Previous break waters and drainage trenches made by him, prevented damage to the majority of roads by the heavy rain.</p> <p>We further made several representations for the grading of the roads to and in Umzamowethu. Reaction was much better this year than previous years.</p>

COMMUNICATION AND NEWS LETTERS Responsible Committee members: Walter Kurten and Joe Meyer.</p> <p>We continued to use the WhatsApp groups to keep members functionally informed. Contents are limited to matters of importance as far as possible. The smaller “Oesterbaaiers” group are utilised for personal requests, for example requests for assistance with transporting of goods and medicine, load shedding and other electricity problems, water problems, etc.</p> <p>Joe offered to compose our annual Newsletter, Oyster Bay News, this year. Elmarie Meyer owner of Oesterbaai Eiendomme, again sponsored the Newsletter. Our sincere thanks to both.</p>
