VOORWOORD:	INTRODUCTION:
<p>Die nuwe verkose lede tot die Bestuurskomitee het tot nuwe energie in die werksaamhede van die Bestuurskomitee gelei. Ons is ook dankbaar vir die ou hardwerkende staatmakers wat voortgaan om hulle energie tot die verbetering van Oesterbaai aan te wend.</p> <p>Soos in vorige jaarverslae vermeld, is hierdie slegs 'n beknopte weergawe van die werksaamhede van die Bestuurskomitee. Die omvang van aktiwiteite is veelvuldig. Dit is nie moontlik om alle insette weer te gee nie.</p> <p>Dit is tog nodig om te meld dat die werk wat die lede van die Bestuurskomitee doen 'n vrywillige diens is. Die versoek (soms eise) van sekere inwoners, lei soms tot frustrasie. Dit is ook opmerksaam dat van hierdie versoek van lede kom, wat nie opbetaalde lede van die OIV is nie.</p> <p>Alhoewel frustrasie steeds ervaar word om noodsaaklike dienste deur die Municipaliteit en Provinsie te verkry, kan ons wel rapporteer dat na die aanstelling van 'n nuwe stadsingenieur, daar tog vordering is betreffende watervoorsiening en interne paaie.</p>	<p>The newly elected members brought renewed energy to the Management Committee. We are also thankful to the hardworking stalwarts. They continue with all their endeavour to better Oyster Bay.</p> <p>As in our previous annual reports, this report is a concise account of the activities of the Management Committee. The activities of the Management Committee is numerous. A comprehensive report of all input, is not possible.</p> <p>We deem it necessary to mention that the services rendered by Management is voluntary. The requests (sometimes demands) of some residents cause frustration. We also see that some of these requests come from members not in good standing with OBRA.</p> <p>Although we at times experience frustration to get essential services performed by the Municipality and Province, the appointment of a new city Engineer resulted in improvement in water supply and internal roads.</p>

FINANCE Responsible Committee Member: Martiens Kuneke We thank our Treasurer for his devoted management of our finances. Martiens will discuss the attached financial statements. The Management Committee endeavors at all times to perform duties as economically possible. The Management Committee is truly thankful towards the families making donations to OBRA. Without your generosity, we will not be able to do much. The existence of OBRA is more than ever dependant on donations from our members.
2. OMGEWINGSAKE Verantwoordelike Komiteelede: Bouwen Schellingerhoudt en Marius Aucamp 2.1 Duine: Bouwen het in diepte navorsing gedoen oor die rehabilitasie en beheer van bewegende duine. Bouwen is bereid om sy navorsing met belangstellende lede te deel. Die Bestuurslede is dit eens dat die periodieke wegwerk van sand na die hoogwatermerk is nie die antwoord vir die probleem nie. Die opvang van bewegende sand met nette/plantmateriaal en later beplanting blyk die aangewese bestuursmetode te wees. Die Munisipaliteit verwyder nou slegs die sand wat by huise aan die Oostekant van Branderstraat opbou en probeer Branderstraat oophou. Die Slangriviermond het hierdie jaar oopgebly.	2. ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS Responsible Committee Members: Bouwen Schellingerhoudt en Marius Aucamp 2.1 Dunes: Bouwen researched the rehabilitation control of moving dunes in depth. He is willing to share his research with members interested. Members of the Management Committee is of the opinion that the periodic moving of sand to the high water mark is not a resolution for the problem. The retaining of the moving sand with shade cloth/vegetation and planting of the right vegetation seems to be the best management method. The Municipality now only remove sand buildup at the houses on the Eastern side of Brander Street and attempt to keep Brander Street open. The Slang River mouth remained open this

Members contributed generously in response to our plea for assistance. Bouwen planted a lot of indigenous trees. It will take years though for the hiking trail to recover to its old splendour.</p>
<p>3. WATERVOORSIENING. Verantwoordelike Komiteelid: Otto Pepler.</p> <p>Watervoorsiening in Oesterbaai is in vergelyking met ander dorpe en stede goed. Die enkele probleme wat ondervind is, kry onmiddellik aandag.</p> <p>Die goeie reën het die fonteine weer tot hulle sterkte van vroeë herstel. Dit dra by tot die verkleuring van die water.</p> <p>Daar is steeds bekommernis oor automatiese chloortoediening wat buite werking is. Die chloor word fisies by die reservour toegedien. Die Stadsingenieur het ons tydens die die GOP vergadering verseker dat die water weekliks getoets word. Addisionele toetse word ook deur Omgewingsgesondheid gedoen. Die water is veilig om te drink.</p>	<p>3. WATER SUPPLY Responsible Committee Member: Otto Pepler</p> <p>In comparison with other towns and cities, the water supply in Oyster Bay is good. The few problems experienced were diligently attended to.</p> <p>The good rains resulted in our fountains flowing as strong as in the long past. This result in colouring of the water.</p> <p>We are still concerned about the automatic chlorine dispenser which is out of order. Chlorine are physically dispensed at the reservoir. The City Engineer assured us during the recent IDP meeting that the water is tested weekly. Additional tests are performed by Environmental health. The water is safe for human consumption.</p>
<p>4. GEMEENSKAPSAAL Verantwoordelike Komiteelid: Adriaan van Wyk.</p> <p>Die saal is die afgelope jaar weer gereeld benut. Huurinkomste het ongelukkig gedaal, omdat die saal meestal deur die Municipaliteit en welsynsorganisasies benut word.</p> <p>Die vensters is nou uiteindelik almal vervang. Dit het byna drie jaar geneem. Die Municipaliteit se instandhoudingsprogram bly maar 'n bron van groot frustrasie.</p>	<p>4. COMMUNITY HALL Responsible Committee Member: Adriaan van Wyk</p> <p>The hall was again often utilized this year. Rental income unfortunately decreased, because the hall is mostly utilized by the Municipality and welfare organizations.</p> <p>The windows has at last all been replaced. This project took nearly three years. The maintenance programme of the Municipality remains a huge source of frustration.</p>

<p>5. AFVALSTORTINGSTERREIN Verantwoordelike Komiteelid: Adriaan van Wyk</p> <p>Die bestuur en instandhouding van die afvalstortingsterrein is bevredigend. Baba Martha Rollison, die mees senior municipale amptenaar in Oesterbaai is betroubaar en neem inisiatief betreffende meer aspekte as wat haar posbeskrywing bepaal.</p> <p>Die skermmuurjies is ongelukkig erg beskadig deur persone wat daarteen vasry asook die vragmotor wat die “skips” aflaai.</p> <p>Versoeke word ontvang vir die daarstel van ‘n terrein vir tuinafval. Humansdorp se stortingsterrein is vir die doel ontwerp. St.Francis met baie meer huise moet ook hulle tuinafval na Humansdorp neem. Die municipaliteit is nie bereid om hieroor te onderhandel nie.</p> <p>Ons versoek weereens dat u tydens vertrek u vullissakke nie op die sypaadjie sal laat nie. Dit word oopgeskeur deur honde, ape ens. Neem u sakke asb. na die stortingsterrein en indien dit gesluit is, plaas dit in een van die blou vullisdromme wat deur die Bestuurskomitee op verskeie plekke in die dorp aangebring is.</p>	<p>5. REFUSE DUMPING SITE Responsible Committee Member: Adriaan van Wyk</p> <p>The management and maintenance of the dumping site is satisfactory. Baba Martha Rollison, the most senior municipal official in Oyster Bay is reliable and take initiative for more aspects than the stipulations of her job description.</p> <p>The guard walls on the sides of the ramp is damaged due to drivers knocking it over, also when skips are delivered.</p> <p>We receive requests for a dumping area for garden refuse. The Humansdorp refuge site has been designed for this purpose. St. Francis' residents all have to take their garden refuge to Humansdorp. The Municipality is not prepared to negotiate this matter.</p> <p>We again request that refuge bags not being left on pavements when residents leave Oyster Bay. Dogs, monkeys etc. tear it open. Please take your refuge bags to the refuse site. If closed at the time, place your bags in one of the blue refuse drums which the Management Committee placed at various sites.</p>
<p>6. PAAIE Verantwoordelike Komiteelid: Otto Pepler en Johan Hennop.</p> <p>Slaggate in die teerpaaie is by meer as een geleentheid met teer gevul. Na elke goeie reënbuï is daar maar weer slaggate. Die stadsingeneur het ons meegedeel dat Kabeljou- en Tunastraat wel op hulle skedule vir herseëling is - ongelukkig geen tydsanduiding nie.</p> <p>Die Provinciale paaie vanaf Humansdorp en St Francisbaai het hierdie jaar gereeld aandag gekry. Ons is veral bly dat dreineringspype wat jare reeds benodig word, aangebrings is. Dit het wel sormwaterskade na swaar reën beduidend verminder.</p>	<p>6. ROADS Responsible Committee Member: Otto Pepler and Johan Hennop</p> <p>Potholes in the tar roads was filled on various occasions. After each good downpour, new potholes appear. The City Manager informed us that Kabeljou and Tuna Streets are on their schedule for re-sealing - no time frame.</p> <p>The Provincial roads from Humansdorp and St Francis Bay received more frequent attention this year. We are glad that more drainage pipes were installed. This was a need for years. It reduced storm water damage with heavy rain.</p>

COMMUNICATION AND NEWS LETTERS</p> <p>Responsible Committee member: Riekie Pienaar and Willie Oosthuizen.</p> <p>OBRA utilizes its WhatsApp groups as our main means of communication. It seems to be successful in view of the number of requests for adding new members/participants.</p> <p>Willie employs a lot of effort in the compilation of a beautiful Newsletter.</p>
<p>8. BRANDWEER</p> <p>Verantwoordelike Komiteelid: Desmond Wolmarans.</p> <p>Ons glo almal is bewus van die brand aan die Oostekant van Oesterbaai. Alhoewel slegs rookskade aan huise aangerig is, was dit 'n skrikwekkende tyd vir inwoners. Ons is steeds dankbaar oor die vrywilligers wat behulpsaam was. Belangrike lesse is geleer.</p> <p>Die reuse brand wat op 'n plaas aan die Westekant van Oesterbaai ontstaan het, het groot dele bos en weiveld vernietig. Die brand is deur stormsterkwind in die rigting van Oesterbaai gedruk. Lodewyk van Rensburg, stasiebevelvoerder van die plaaslike NSRI se toetrede om brandbestryding deur helikopters te verkry, het 'n ramp vir Ooesterbaai afgewend.</p> <p>Desmond het 'n omvattende brandrisikobepaling en voorstelle vir beter brandbestrydingvoorkoming en -bestryding aan die hoof van Rampbestuur voorgelê. Ons wag nog vir terugvoer.</p> <p>Die Municipale Bestuurder het ons meegedeel dat die bou van die brandweerdepot as 'n behoefte van die Geïntegreerde Ontwikkelingsplan, verwyder is.</p> <p>Ons ontvang sedert 2022 beloftes van meer brandkrane in die dorp. Daar is heelwat huise wat vêr van brandkrane af is.</p>	<p>8. FIRE BRIGADE</p> <p>Responsible Committee member: Desmond Wolmarans</p> <p>We believe all are informed about the fire on the Eastern Side of Oyster Bay. Although some homes only suffered smoke damage, it was a terrifying experience for residents. We are grateful for the assistance of all the volunteers who assisted. All learned important lessons.</p> <p>A huge fire which originated on a farm on the Western side of Oyster Bay destroyed huge areas of bush and farmland. This fire was pushed by gale force wind in the direction of Oyster Bay. The action of Lodewyk van Rensburg of our local NSRI, to obtain helicopters to fight the fire, averted a disaster for Oyster Bay.</p> <p>Desmond compiled a comprehensive fire risk assessment and fire prevention proposal, which he submitted to the Head of Disaster Management. No response was received.</p> <p>The Municipal Manager informed us that building of the fire depot has been removed from the the Integrated Development plan as a need.</p> <p>The Municipality promise since 2022 that more fire hydrants will be installed in Oyster Bay. Many houses are far from fire hydrants.</p> <p>Riekie ensured that fire extinguishers were</p>

9. UMZAMOWETHU Verantwoordelike Komiteelid: Adriaan van Wyk Die Bestuur het besluit om ons werksaamhede in Umzamowethu af te skaal vanweë min sukses en die veranderende profiel van die inwoners. Tog het die hoeveelheid versoek vir bystand maar soos vorige jare aangehou. Bouwen het 'n omvattende plan aan die Stadsingenieur voorgelê om die dreineringsprobleem in Umzamowerhu aan te spreek. Ons wag. Bouwen het ook 'n dreineringsloot laat grou wat die probleem gedeeltelik aangespreek het. Die HOP huise in Umzamowethu het nuwe aluminium vensters en deure gekry. Die dakke is ook herstel. Die befondsing hiervoor het van die Kouga Windphase gekom. Die swak sosio-ekonomiese situasie, die gepaardgaande drank- en dwelmmisbruik en die toenemende werkloosheid, veral onder jongmense, bly die grootste uitdaging.	9. UMZAMOWETHU Responsible Committee Member: Adriaan van Wyk Management decided to limit its involvement in Umzamowethu, due to little success and the changing profile of residents. The requests for assistance remained the same as in previous years. Bouwen submitted a comprehensive plan to the City engineer to address the drainage problem in Umzamowethu. No response as yet. Bouwen also had drainage trench created, which improved the drainage problem. The HOP houses in Umzamowethu were fitted with new aluminium windows and doors. Roofs were also repaired. Kouga Wind farms funded this project. The bad socio economic situation, the associated alcohol and drug abuse and the huge number of unemployed, especially the young, remains the most serious challenge.
